MRRS Automatic Process Update

Naval Information Warfare Center (NIWC) provides technological and engineering support critical to information warfare for the U.S. Navy, as well as for Marine Corps, Air Force, Army and Coast Guard programs. Systems development and support includes basic research and prototype development through systems engineering, and integration to life cycle support of fielded systems. NIWC supports and manages the HIV Management Service (HMS), a web-based application and software system that facilitates the execution of NBIMC's mission.

On, Friday, April 8, 2022, NIWC provided significant changes to the frequency of reporting Navy and Marine Corps force testing data to the Medical Readiness Reporting System (MRRS), improving the MRRS update process from twice a week to a reoccurring 2-hour update cycle.
