The HIV Evaluation Unit (HETU) for the Navy Bloodborne Infection Management Center monitors active-duty, positive service members for the Navy, Marines, and Coast Guard per SECNAVINST 5300.20F. HETU ensures that every service member receives a clinical evaluation and laboratory draw every six months to remain compliant and healthy.

Following an Initial Positive result, the service member will be connected with an HETU Coordinator at one of four military bases to assist them in making an initial evaluation appointment. The service member will remain in contact with their assigned HETU Coordinator by email or telephone and respond to correspondence initiated by the coordinator. Continual communication between the member and the HETU Coordinator also supports fluid scheduling of re-evaluation and laboratory appointments which occur every six months as the member continues to serve.
