- In 2023, the Defense Health Agency (DHA) launched an initiative to expand access to HIV Pre-exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) in the DoD. This initiative was in response to the DHA-PI 6025.29 titled "Provision of Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) for Persons at High Risk of Acquiring HIV Infection", which directs Military Treatment Facilities (MTFs) to provide a pathway to access HIV PrEP for all beneficiaries at increased risk for acquiring HIV infection. This initiative aligns with the National HIV/AIDS strategy 2022-2025, which calls on government agencies to accelerate efforts to end the HIV epidemic in the U.S. by 2030.
- HIV PrEP is a daily oral pill or a bimonthly injection that can lower an individual's risk of acquiring HIV infection by greater than 90% when taken as directed. Oral PrEP and injectable PrEP are covered benefits under Tricare; however, the latter has limited availability within the Military Health System (MHS) currently. Despite HIV PrEP's high efficacy, it is estimated that less than 17% of Active-Duty Service members who may benefit from taking this medication were prescribed PrEP. The DHA's HIV PrEP Working Group developed resources to promote healthcare provider training and patient awareness. These resources include a comprehensive HIV PrEP toolkit for primary care providers and patient education materials.

#### **B:** Instructions for SOT G Orders

- The HIV -1/O/2 CDD test designated at BUMED only (previously called the SOTG test in CHCS) is ordered for patients on HIV PrEP. This test includes the 4th generation HIV antibody/antigen screen AND qualitative RNA testing.

#### C: SOT G Provider Results View



- This document provides visuals for SOT G testing from the provider's view. An example of a **negative** screening and **negative** HIV Nucleic Acid Test results in MHS Genesis and JLV Genesis are displayed. **Positive** screening results, **positive** differentiation, and **positive** HIV Nucleic Acid Test results are also displayed from the MHS Genesis and JLV Genesis point of view. Test results for final interpretation by the provider are highlighted in yellow.

    - a. Navy Contractor HIV and Hepatitis Testing Algorithm




#### **Document B: Instructions for SOT G Orders**

1. Go to Orders and in the search box, type HIV. When the following window shows, select **HIV 1/O/2 CDD Future Order**, **Blood**, **Routine**, **Lab Collect** (highlighted in blue).






2. Click on the "Details" tab, go to "Source of Test L.C." and select **BUMED only** 






3. Click on the Order Comments tab, and type **PREP Candidate** in the Order comments box.






4. Click on the Diagnosis tab. Click on "Add +". Type in **Z20.2** and press the binoculars to search. Click on "Contact with and (suspected) exposure to infections with a predominantly sexual mode of transmission "(highlighted box on the lower right).







#### MHS Genesis- NEGATIVE screening and NEGATIVE HIV Nucleic Acid Test final interpretation results




### JLV View – NEGATIVE screening and NEGATIVE HIV Nucleic Acid Test final interpretation results






#### MHS Genesis- POSITIVE screening results, POSITIVE Differentiation and POSITIVE HIV Nucleic Acid Test final interpretation results



#### JLV Genesis- POSITIVE screening results, POSITIVE Differentiation and POSITIVE HIV Nucleic Acid Test final interpretation results



#### **NAVY CONTRACTOR HIV AND HEPATITIS TESTING ALGORITHM**


