1. I am proud to announce the Navy winners of the 2020 Blue H Navy Surgeon General's Health Promotion and Wellness Award, managed by the Navy and Marine Corps Public Health Center (NMCPHC).
2. The Navy fleet command categories recognize excellence in workplace health promotion policies, activities and outcomes. The medical treatment facility category recognizes excellence in clinical primary prevention services, community health promotion, and medical staff health. Health topics covered include responsible drinking, violence and injury free living, healthy eating, active living, psychological health, sexual health, tobacco free living, and weight management. Awards may be earned at three levels: Gold Star, Silver Eagle, and Bronze Anchor. Every organization that applied received at least the Bronze Anchor level award. Commands that achieved a minimum of 50 percent of available points for every topic earned the Silver Eagle level award. Commands that achieved at least 50 percent of available points in every topic, achieved key must-do criteria and also achieved 80 percent of the total available points, earned the Gold Star level award.
3. Primary prevention policies and activities in Navy and Marine Corps workplaces, communities, and medical treatment facilities are critical to maintaining a fit and ready force. Reducing behavioral risk also enhances individual quality of life and reduces long-term healthcare costs.
4. The pandemic brought many challenges to the requirements for this award. Commands readily met this by taking classes virtually, conducting socially distanced fitness challenges, and ensuring health information was passed electronically.
5. I commend the 441 Navy and Marine Corps winners. The total breakdown is 206 Gold Star, 50 Silver Eagle, and 185 Bronze Anchor award winners. I invite all commands to participate in the Blue H in 2021.
6. Marine Corps command winners include 66 total, of which 26 were Gold Star, 7 Silver Eagle, and 33 Bronze Anchor.
