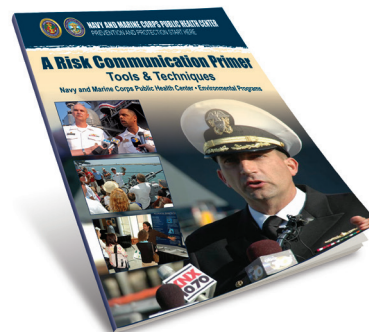
Purpose

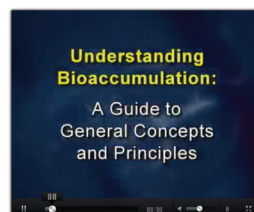

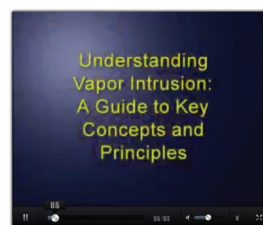

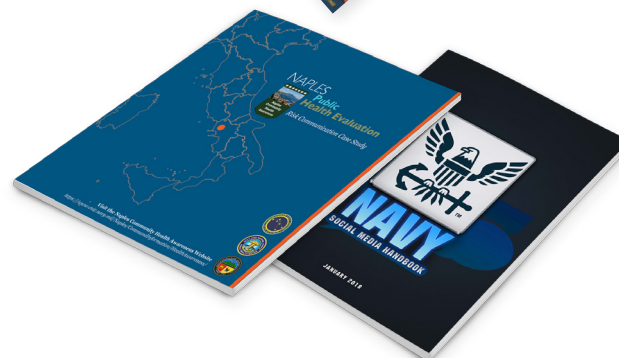
