Subj: ORDER TO AMEND ALL NAVAL RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL PERMITS  
Ref: (a) U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission License 45-23645-01NA  
(b) OPNAVINST 6470.3A Naval Radiation Safety Committee

1. Purpose: To permanently ban Mr. Scott W. Frampton, LCDR(ret) USN, radiation safety officer at Naval Medical Center San Diego (start date: 29 August 2005) from working with radioactive materials held under a Naval Radioactive Material Permit (NRMP). This order is effective immediately.

2. Discussion:

a. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has issued a Master Materials License (MML), ref (a), to the Navy for the acquisition, use, storage, transportation, and disposal of radioactive materials not associated with the Naval Nuclear Propulsion Program or Naval Nuclear Weapons Program. In accordance with reference (b), the Naval Radiation Safety Committee (NRSC) is responsible for management and oversight of the Navy's MML. The NRSC issues NRMPs to naval commands that have submitted an application to use radioactive material and have met administrative and operational requirements. In addition, the NRSC may issue orders that modify permit conditions in a permit or multiple permits.

3. Procedures: This NRSC order adds the following condition to your NRMP(s):

a. This NRMP is prohibited from allowing Mr. Scott W. Frampton any occupational involvement in NRMP activities.

4. Action:

a. Organizations involved in the use of radiological materials permitted under the MML are directed to comply with

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this order and all requirements in the conditions and tie-downs of their permits.

b. Permittees will file this order with their permit. This order will be included as a condition of the NRMP upon the next amendment or renewal

5. This order is effective immediately.
