Recommended Attendees: Environmental Health Officers, Preventive Medicine Officers, Preventive Medicine Technicians, Independent Duty Corpsmen, and those operating in the capacity of Preventive Medicine Authority per BUMEDINST 6240.10D.

Also, NAVFAC Public Works personnel, water plant/system operators responsible for installation drinking water protection, treatment, sampling, testing, delivery, and Installation Water Quality Board members. CEUs are available for this course for water operators personnel through NAVFAC HQ.

There is no cost or fee required to attend, but the individual's command is responsible for travel, lodging and per diem expenses.

Attendees will receive a list of read-ahead materials that they must be familiar with prior to the course.

Attendees should bring paper and pen or a laptop for note taking. A computer is NOT required for the course.

Course will cover drinking water requirements, various program such as Lead, Legionella, basic chlorine and coliform sampling, public notification, laboratory issues, organization structure, water source, treatment, distribution, compliance monitoring, and much more. Daily tabletop exercises will also be included.
