

OBLIGATIONS 25 Feb 2022

The overriding instruction for obligation is DODI 6000.13. The information below is a small sample of obligation information. Please contact the Navy GME office or your Corps Planner for additional direction on Active Duty Service Obligation concerns.

ADO means active duty obligation

GME is Graduate Medical Education

Concurrent means served at the same time

Consecutively means served after (not concurrent with)

FTIS is Full-Time Inservice

FTOS is Full-Time Outservice (training in a civilian training institution)

OFI is Other Federal Institution, i.e. NIH, Congress, Madigan

NO GME ADO CAN BE SERVED WHILE IN GME TRAINING. In other words, if you are currently in GME training, you are not paying back ADO (active duty obligation).

HPSP, HSCP, ROTC AND USNA ADO CAN BE SERVED CONCURRENTLY WITH FTIS (full time inservice) or OFI ADO. In other words, if you have a 4-year HPSP ADO while going into a 2-YEAR FTIS residency. Your ADO will still be 4 years once you complete that residency.

HPSP, ROTC AND USNA ADO ARE SERVED CONSECUTIVELY WITH ONE ANOTHER. In other words, if you have a 4-year HPSP ADO and a 4-year ROTC ADO, you owe 8 years ADO.

FTOS (full-time outservice) GME IS SERVED CONSECUTIVELY WITH RESIDUAL ADO. IN OTHER WORDS, FTOS OBLIGATION IS ADDED TO ANY RESIDUAL OBLIGATIONS. For example, if you are going into training and have 2 year residual HPSP obligation, then went into a 2 year FTOS fellowship, you would have a 4-year ADO.

OFI, FTIS and FTOS ADO are all served consecutively with one another. In other words if you have any residual OFI, FTIS, or FTOS ADO, then go into another FTIS, OFI or FTOS program, those ADO's are always additive to one another (served consecutively).

IN A MILITARY FACILITY (FTIS/OFI) A MEMBER WILL INCUR GME ADO OF ½ YEAR FOR EACH ½ YEAR OR PORTION THEREOF BUT THE MINIMUM ADO

AT THE COMPLETION OF THE GME PERIOD SHALL NOT BE LESS THAN 2 YEARS.

A MEMBER SUBSIDIZED BY THE DOD DURING TRAINING IN A CIVILIAN FACILITY (FTOS) SHALL INCUR AN ADO OF ½ YEAR FOR EACH ½ YEAR OR PORTION THEREOF BUT THE MINIMUM ADO AT THE COMPLETION OF THE GME PERIOD SHALL NOT BE LESS THAN 2 YEARS.

GME ADO IS SERVED IN ORDER THEY OCCUR IF YOU HAVE CONSECUTIVE ADO'S. In other words if you have a 4-year HPSP ADO, then did a FTIS internship year (ADO neutral) then did a 2-year FTOS residency, You would have a 6 year ADO. Then if you did a 2 year utilization tour, you would still have 2 years of HPSP ADO and 2 years of FTOS ADO for a total of 4 years ADO at the completion of that utilization tour.

FTIS INTERNSHIP YEAR IS ADO NEUTRAL. In other words, during your internship, you neither incur ADO nor payback any residual ADO.
