

Military-Affiliated Civilian Partnership Programs – AY 2027

Navy Medicine has established enduring partnerships with the residency programs listed below. Each institution reserves one or more training positions for a Navy applicant selected by the Joint Graduate Medical Education Selection Board (JGMESB).

(1) The partnership institutions may have unique requirements for supporting documentation, interviews, and deadlines that differ from those of the JGMESB. These institutions are not obligated to interview all applicants.

(2) Applicants seeking consideration for partnership programs must also apply to the JGMESB as outlined in the annual BUMEDNOTE 1524. Applicants remain eligible to apply for military Full-Time In-Service (FTIS) programs, non-partnership Full-Time Out-Service (FTOS) positions, and civilian deferment via the Navy Active Duty Delay Specialist (NADDS) program.

Interview Requests & Required Documentation

To request an interview, please email the respective program directly. Programs may require the following information:

- **Demographics & Status:** Name, current scholarship program (HPSP, HSCP, USU, or active duty physician), email address, and phone number.
- **Curriculum Vitae (CV):** Current CV, including additional details about any listed research (if applicable).
- **Personal Statement:** A Letter of Intent or Personal Statement (applicants may use the same statement prepared for their Graduate Medical Education (GME) application packet).
- **Board Scores:** A self-report of USMLE and/or COMLEX scores. Include the number of attempts and any failed attempts. If USMLE/COMLEX Step/Level 2 scores are not yet available, provide the scheduled exam date.
- **Academic Record:** A self-report of any failed courses or clinical rotations during medical school.
- **Adverse Comments:** A self-report of any current and/or previous adverse comments in medical school transcripts, military records, or GME records that will appear in your GME application. *If you are unsure of what to disclose, contact the appropriate office submitting the information (e.g., your school's Student Affairs office).*
