

HMCM Atiba D. Mathlin (SW/AW/FMF), USN

Command Senior Enlisted Advisor

Master Chief Mathlin is a native of New York State. He entered the Navy after graduating high school in September 1999. He began his career as an undesignated seaman onboard USS THACH (FFG 43) in San Diego, CA where he completed a Western Pacific Deployment to 7th and 5th Fleet AOR. During this tour he was selected for Hospital Corpsman "A" School with follow-on training at Field Medical Service School in Camp LeJeune, NC earning the 8404 NEC. Upon completion of his training he was assigned to the National Naval Medical Center in Bethesda, MD as part of the USNS Comfort Detachment. While station at Bethesda he was assigned to the Surgery Department. He deployed with the USNS Comfort to OIF in 2003 and served as the Leading Petty Officer for the Intensive Care Unit.

After returning from OIF he reported to 3RD Marine Logistics Group in Okinawa, Japan where he was assigned to Engineer Support Battalion. While there he completed several deployments/joint training exercises throughout the Pacific AOR and returned to Iraq in support of mobility enhancement and counter IED operations. HMCM Mathlin Graduated the Surface Force Independent Duty Corpsman "C" School in June 2009 and reported to Combined Arms Training Center Camp Fuji, Japan as the Senior Medical Department Representative. His subsequent assignments included Marine Corps Security Forces Regiment in Williamsburg, VA, USS PAUL HAMILTON (DDG 60) in Pearl Harbor, HI, Afloat Training Group in Norfolk, VA and USS CHANCELLORSVILLE (CG 62) homeported in Yokosuka Japan.

HMCM Mathlin reported onboard Naval Medical Leader and Professional Development Command as the Senior Enlisted Advisor in June 2021. Master Chief Mathlin is a graduate of the U.S. Navy War College, Senior Enlisted Academy, the CMC/COB Course (Class 21120), the Navy Medical Professional Development Center, Executive Medical Department Enlisted Course, and the Surface Warfare Medical Institute, Surface Force Independent Duty Corpsman course. He earned a Bachelor of Science in Healthcare Management from Trident University International and a Masters in Business Administration from the George Washington University.
