

## HMCM (SW/AW) Marvin T. Ramos United States Navy

Master Chief Ramos is a native of Cavite, Philippines. He migrated to the United States in July of 1997 and enlisted in the United States Navy in October of 1999. He completed Hospital Corpsman "A" school in 2000 and subsequently attended Respiratory Therapy "C" School at the Naval School of Health Science, San Diego, CA.

Operationally, Master Chief Ramos completed two Western Pacific (WESTPAC) deployment in support of OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM and OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM (OEF) while assigned with the Fleet Surgical Team FIVE. In 2008, he was augmented to deploy with Expeditionary Medical Facility Kuwait and served as Leading Petty Officer for Troop Medical Clinic in support of OEF. After his selection to Chief Petty Officer in 2010, he deployed as the Senior Enlisted Leader (SEL) for the Directorate of Nursing Services onboard USNS MERCY (T-AH 19) in support of Pacific Partnership 2012 mission. Immediately after, he reported onboard USS NIMITZ (CVN-68) as the LCPO for Dental Department while also serving as the Command Drug and Alcohol Program Advisor. Shortly after reporting, he completed a 9-month WESTPAC deployment and was then selected to Senior Chief Petty Officer in 2013. Also during his NIMITZ tour, he served as the Health Services Department LCPO and Command Family Advocacy Representative. In 2017, he was selected to the rank of Master Chief Petty Officer.

His shore assignments include Naval Medical Center San Diego, U.S. Naval Hospital Sigonella Italy, and U.S. Navy Medicine Readiness and Training Command Guantanamo Bay Cuba, where he served as SEL, Command Activity Manning Manager and two Command Senior Enlisted Leader tours. He is currently assigned to Navy Medicine Operation and Training Command DET Naval Expeditionary Medical Training Institute as the Senior Enlisted Advisor.

Master Chief Ramos earned the designation of Enlisted Surface Warfare Specialist and Enlisted Aviation Warfare Specialist. His personal awards include the Meritorious Service Medal (2 awards), Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal (4 awards), Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (2 awards), Good Conduct Medal (7 awards), Humanitarian Service Medal, Military Outstanding Volunteer Service Medal, Sea Service Ribbon (5 awards), Overseas Service Ribbon (3 awards) and various unit and campaign awards. Master Chief Ramos resides in Chula Vista, CA with his wife Jemelle and their two children, Audrey and Haley.
