SWMI is located in Building 14 on the Naval Medical Center San Diego compound. All students with orders to SWMI must report to PA Admin, on the 1st deck, room 117, Monday thru Friday 0800 to 1430, or SWMI Admin, on the 2<sup>nd</sup> deck, room 213, 0730 to 1600. After hours, check in at the quarterdeck, 1<sup>st</sup> deck, room 106. If no one is available in building 14, check in at NMCSD quarterdeck, 1<sup>st</sup> deck, building one.

When applying for housing you need to provide a copy of your orders, Page 2 showing all dependents and a completed form <u>DD1746</u>. The CNIC website also has information on temporary lodging as well. <u>Please note that geographic bachelor housing is no longer</u> <u>available to students</u>. All students will receive basic allowance for housing and need to find residence other than the barracks.

If you are a single military member (you have no dependents), email HM1 Williams, two months prior to PCS so a DLA letter from the gaining command can be generated and sent to member (only applies for E-6 and below).
