Updates: About 46,100 DoD personnel are supporting COVID relief

- **U.S. Northern Command** is responsible for DoD's COVID-19 operations in support of FEMA and has concluded all COVID-19 medical operations in support of FEMA, state, and local authorities.
- More than 37,400 members of the **National Guard** are supporting COVID-19 response efforts at their governors' direction.
- The **U.S. Army Corps of Engineers** has 64 FEMA Mission Assignments totaling \$1.8 billion (5 open / 59 closed), with 102 deployed in support of COVID-19 response operations. USACE has assessed 1,155 sites for use as Alternate Care Facilities (ACFs) with 36 of 38 ACF construction contracts complete.
