### The DOD DCTT:

- Maintains ADA recognition.
- Schedules group appointments in MHS Video Connect.
- Invites patients with information provided by you.
- Created synchronous curriculum that counts for class at any location.

### The Medical Home Team:

- Provides patient names, emails & dates requested to be invited to class.
- Submits patient note in your EMR – cut & paste available to make this easy & quick.
- Conducts follow-up on patient as needed by ADA – database provided to assist with correct info.
- Submits database to DCTT three times per year.
- Potentially bills third party insurance for DSMT.
