The VA/DOD DESC:

- Maintains ADA recognition.
- Schedules group appointments in MHS Video Connect.
- Invites patients with information provided by you.
- Created synchronous curriculum that counts for class at any location.

The Medical Home Team:

- Provides patient names, emails & desired class dates to VA/DOD DESC.
- Generates patient note in the EMR: Standardized note available.
- Schedules & conducts follow-up encounters to document outcomes (see database for required info).
- Submits database to VA/DOD DESC three times per year.
- Codes encounters for potential billing for DSMES. Can earn reimbursement from insurance companies.
