

Job Certification Examinations

Job certification examinations are for jobs that have specific medical standards, licensing requirements or are mandated by instruction. These include: firefighter, respirator certification, forklift operator, childcare worker, motor vehicle operator, explosives handler and driver, crane operator, etc. The examination frequency is variable, based on the certification

Examination Frequency (Most of those not listed are completed annually)	
Exam	Completion Frequency
Forklift Operator	up to age 60 years => 5 years Age 60 & above => annual
Explosive Motor Vehicle Operator	2 Years
Explosive Handler	Up to age 60 => 5 years Age 60 & above => annual
Firefighters	annual
Weight Handling Equipment Crane, Rigger, Climber	2 years
Asbestos Current Worker	Annual
Asbestos – Past Worker 0-10 years since first exposure	5 years
Asbestos – Past Worker 10+ years since first exposure	Up to age 34 => 5 years Age 35-44 => 2 years Age 45 & above => annual

Some examinations require that the employee fast i.e. have nothing to eat or drink for 10 hours prior to their appointment.

Some examples of exams with a fasting requirement are:

- Police / Security
- Explosive Handler / Driver
- Firefighter
- Forklift Operator
- Motor Vehicle Operator
- Hazardous Waste Worker / Responder
- NCIS
- Crane Operator (Weight Handling Equipment)
