



MFH Assignment when Pet Dog Involved

- Housing applicants are advised via DEA, Web site & housing office not to bring a pet dog until it is determined if they will be assigned to a unit (townhouse) that allows dogs.
- Members arriving PCS with a dog are assigned housing in the same manner as other applicants. If the unit assigned allows a dog (townhouse) the member will be assigned to it; and if not the member will be required to move off base and be authorized housing allowances under the provision that "an undue hardship is required". Later applications for assignment to MFH will not be permitted unless applicant certifies they no longer own a pet dog.
- A pet dog acquired after a member's PCS arrival is not considered under any circumstances. Members refusing assignment to MFH will not be authorized housing allowances.
- Applicants declining assignment to MFH may reapply one time only after living off base for three months, and will be placed on the applicable waiting list with a control date of the date of application. There is no guarantee that a townhouse will be assigned the second go-around since they will be offered the first housing unit in chronological order of the available date on the list of vacant units. Moves will be at their own expense.
